Technique, Health and Vocal Awareness

- Suitable for ages 12 and older with any background and skill level.
- Class sizes up to 35 students.
- Paper Laryngeal Model making requires desk space and classroom resources.
- Includes anatomical breakdowns of the voice with interactive vocal exercises.
- A larger focus on vocal health and preservation is optional.
